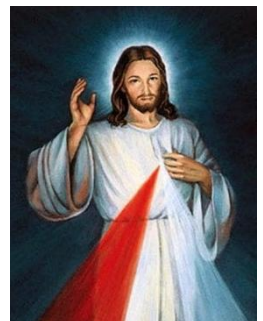

## THE WORD THIS WEEK

During this year's Easter season, the 1st reading is from the Acts of the Apostles, and the 2nd reading is from the Book of Revelation, the last book of the Bible. Today's excerpt from Acts describes the courage of the first disciples who were bold enough to meet in the Temple precincts and carry on the healing work of Jesus. In the reading from the Book of Revelation, John introduces his vision, giving a message of encouragement to the early Christians who were suffering persecution. The Gospel, from St. John, tells how Jesus appears on the evening of his resurrection and helps those who doubt to believe. He brings the gift of peace.
