## Roman Station Churches

### **Monday of Holy Week: St Praxedes (*Santa Prassede*)**

One of the oldest churches in Rome, established by Pope Evaristus in 112. The current church was commissioned by Pope Hadrian I around the year 780 to house the relics of St. Praxedes & St. Pudentiana, the daughters of St. Pudens, traditionally St. Peter's first Christian convert in Rome. Santa Prassede also houses an alleged segment of the pillar or column upon which Jesus was flogged before his crucifixion in Jerusalem. The most famous element of the church are the mosaics, commissioned by Pope Paschal I in the 9<sup>th</sup> centu
