## THE WORD THIS WEEK

Today we hear the story of the sending out of the seventy-two. In effect these were the first missionaries in the name of Jesus, and what he asked them to do is what we too are asked to do: to wish peace to places we visit, to announce the Kingdom and to pray in the name of Jesus for healing for the sick. They did this and came back rejoicing at the success of the message. Before we hear this Gospel, we have heard an exuberant declaration of all kinds of goodness the Lord will send us, including peace, flowing like a river. God is portrayed as a mother comforting us, her children. The psalm anticipates another strand of the Gospel, that of telling the world of all the good things he bestows on us. We are told to have joy in him, as Isaiah tells us in his opening words. 'Rejoice' is also in the last sentence of the Gospel; there is no doubt of today's message.

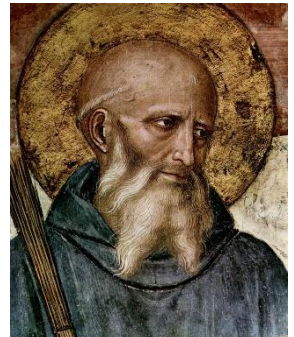
**Welcome** to Fr Andrew Robinson from Oscott College who will be here next weekend to supply while Fr Patrick is in Jerusalem (12-19 July).

## SAINT OF THE WEEK

### ***St Benedict***

Born at Norcia in Umbria c.480. After studying at Rome, he led a life of solitude in Subiaco and gathered disciples around him, and then went on to Monte Cassino. Here he founded a well-known monastery and wrote his Rule, as a result of which he has been called the Father of monasticism in the West. He died on 21 March 547, but from the 8<sup>th</sup> century he has been venerated on 11 July in many places
